ONGOING TRAINING

- Review information about Standards on NFSN website: nationalfamilysupport network.org
- Download Standards from NFSN website
- Participate in a Standards Overview presentation or webinar
- Review recorded Standards Overview webinar
- Plan out next steps along Continuum
- Talk with other Programs that have implemented Standards

- Share information about Standards with other stakeholders, such as partner organizations and funders
- Encourage stakeholders to participate in Standards Overview webinar
- Encourage stakeholders to review recorded Standards Overview webinar
- Review and discuss Standards with Program team

- Identify upcoming Standards Certification Training to attend
- Have Program teams participate that include both management and direct service staff
- Be oriented to using Standards and program implementation tools
- Complete Certification Training and become certified for two years

- Develop a team, plan, and timeline for completing the Program Self-Assessment Tool
- Conduct team meeting(s) to complete the Program Self-Assessment Tool
- Ensure Program staff use the Staff Self-Reflection Checklist regularly
- Highlight a question from the Staff Self-Reflection Checklist each week in a staff team email
- Ask families to complete the Participant Survey

- Review/share data from tools with stakeholders, including Program participants
- Based on reviewing data from tools, develop an action plan for the particular Standards and Indicators to focus on
- Share action plan with stakeholders
- Include Standards language, data from the tools, and action plan in grant proposals

- Conduct ongoing Program team check-ins on implementing the Program action plan
- Report back to stakeholders on Standards implementation action plan progress
- Complete Program Self-Assessment Tool annually
- Hold staff/Program meetings focusing on particular sections of the Standards
- Regularly administer, collect, and analyze
 Participant Survey data.
 Use results to modify
 Program accordingly
- Ensure new Program team members are trained and certified on the Standards

- Dive deeper into the 5 sections of the Standards with additional training/ technical assistance for Program teams on:
- Family Centeredness
- Family Strengthening
- Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion
- CommunityStrengthening
- Evaluation
- Complete Re-Certification training and become re-certified for two years
